Registration Conditions:

Non-Refundable One-time Registration Fee: \$50

Camps are four to five weeks long and camps may not be divided.

Camp Tuition Deposit:

Amount of first camp is due April 30th

Withdrawal from any camp after May 1st forfeits tuition

Refund/Withdrawal Conditions:

All written refund requests must be made before May 1st

No refunds given after May 1st

Missed days at camp are non-refundable

Camp Billing:

Full tuition due **before** 1st of the month preceding camps

Tuition received after the 1st of the month results in a \$25 late fee

Camp Hours:

Camp hours are from 9am – 3pm

Additional time for part-time and school day campers: \$20/ hour (billed in half hour increments)
